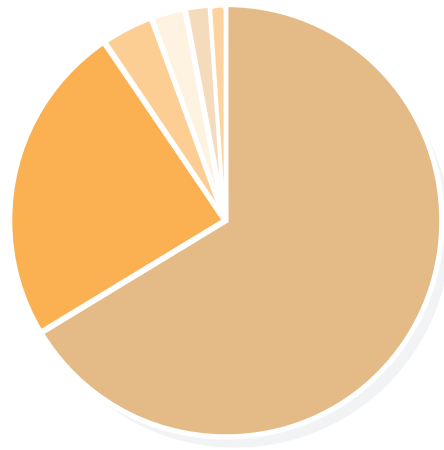

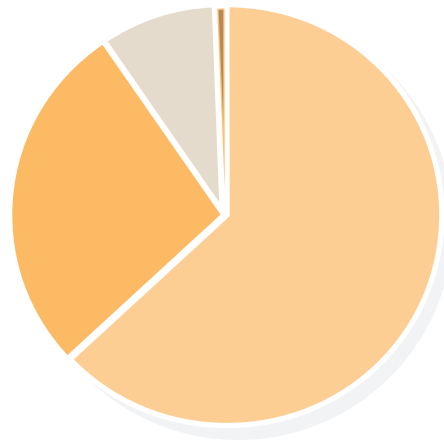

Maximizing Your Gift


Donors can meet their financial goals AND maximize their philanthropic giving through sound and timely gift planning. For instance, you can now make a distribution from your IRA to Seniorsfirst without incurring tax on the withdrawal. Temporary legislation allows donors 70½ years of age and older to make cash gifts totaling up to \$100,000 from a Traditional or Roth IRA to qualified charities (such as the Seniorsfirst Foundation). Whereas these distributions were previously taxable, they are now excludable from gross income, eliminating the income tax penalty for such charitable gifts.

Charitable Remainder Trusts

This past year Valley Manor was the grateful beneficiary of a Charitable Remainder Trust (CRT) established in 1989 by former Valley Manor resident Marietta Dryer. In establishing this CRT, the donor:

- received an income tax deduction upon creation of the trust,
- retained a stream of income for herself for her lifetime,
- reduced the value of the trust assets for estate tax purposes when she died,
- provided a stream of income to her assistant for her lifetime,
- and now provides a significant benefit to Valley Manor 20 years later!
